The first bid opened was submitted by RAP Construction, Texarkana with a total bid amount of \$408,155.09. There was immediately a discrepancy discovered as the total bid amount of \$408,155.09 did not match the tabulated bid amount of \$404,930.00. Jeff Dixon, Craft & Tull, said that he would sort it during the formal tabulation. Mayor Jordan returned all paperwork to its original envelope.

Mayor Jordan opened the second bid, which was submitted by Schiralli Construction Corp, Wilson, OK, with a total bid amount of \$450,600.49. Mayor Jordan returned all paperwork to its original envelope.

Mayor Jordan then handed both bid envelopes to Jeff Dixon for him to tabulate the bids.

The board agreed to continue on with the meeting while the tabulation was being done.

5. Discussion, consideration, and possible action (approval, rejection, amendment, and/or postponement) on the approval of a Master Services Agreement (MSA) with Benchmark Engineering Firm, as submitted by Charles Hinkle, for services related to the Mako Road Task Order project.

Town Administrator Adam Vossen opened the discussion by explaining Benchmark Engineering Firm would provide inspection service on the Mako Road project, and all other future road projects. He then introduced Charles Hinkle, who was personally in attendance from Benchmark Engineering Firm. Mr. Hinkle stated that he is currently working with the Oklahoma Department of Transportation (ODOT) on the local U.S. Highway 259 project providing the same inspection services. His company has set up a civil engineering lab that will be used to test concrete, the proper density of asphalt, and to make sure all
